Manager's Message


Do you like reading the newspaper but don't want to pay for an expensive subscription? A benefit of having a SLO Library card is free access to online newspapers. The library provides digital access to the *New York Times*, *The Tribune*, and the *Wall Street Journal*. To access these newspapers, go to the library homepage at www.slolibrary.org. Select the tab labeled Digital, click on the newspaper of your choice and enter your library card barcode number. For *New York Times* and *Wall Street Journal* you will have to create an account using an email address and creating a password. Enjoy reading from home on your computer or from anywhere on your mobile device.

Are you a news hound and want more news? Find interesting full-text articles from all over the globe on topics ranging from economics, government, international issues, environment, people, or health just to name a few on our online learning resource called Access World News. To reach Access World News start from the library homepage, select the Reference tab and click on Online Learning. Scroll down to the Print Media heading and select Access World News. Explore the thousands of articles available there.
