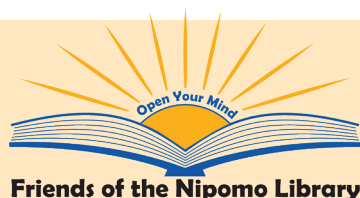
Manager's Message
